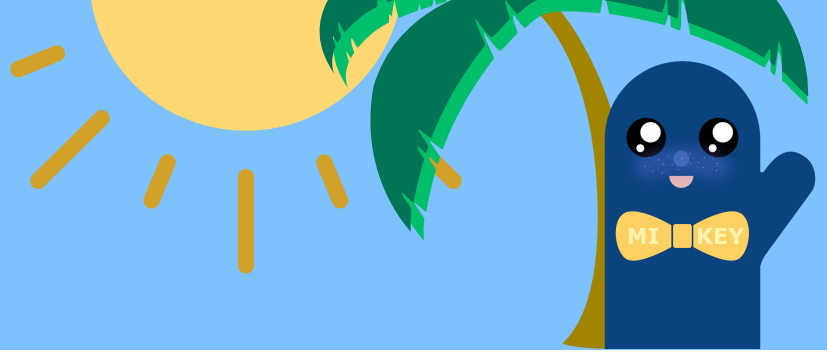

Bulliten Editor/Webmaster Call

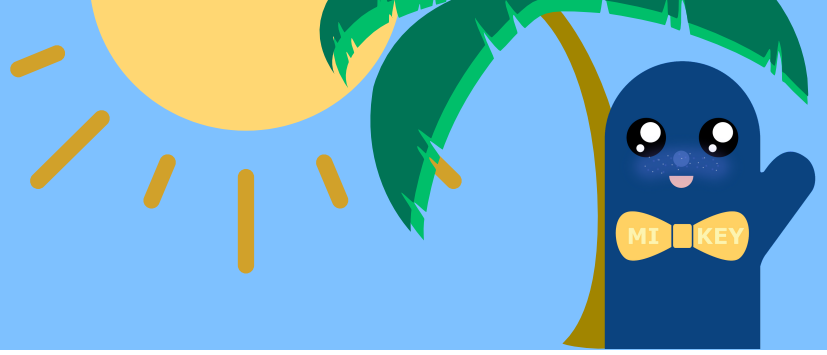

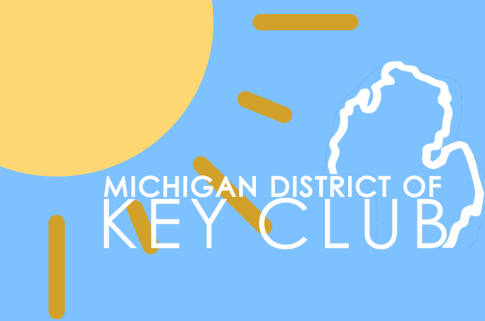
Park Cleanup

Chalk the Driveways

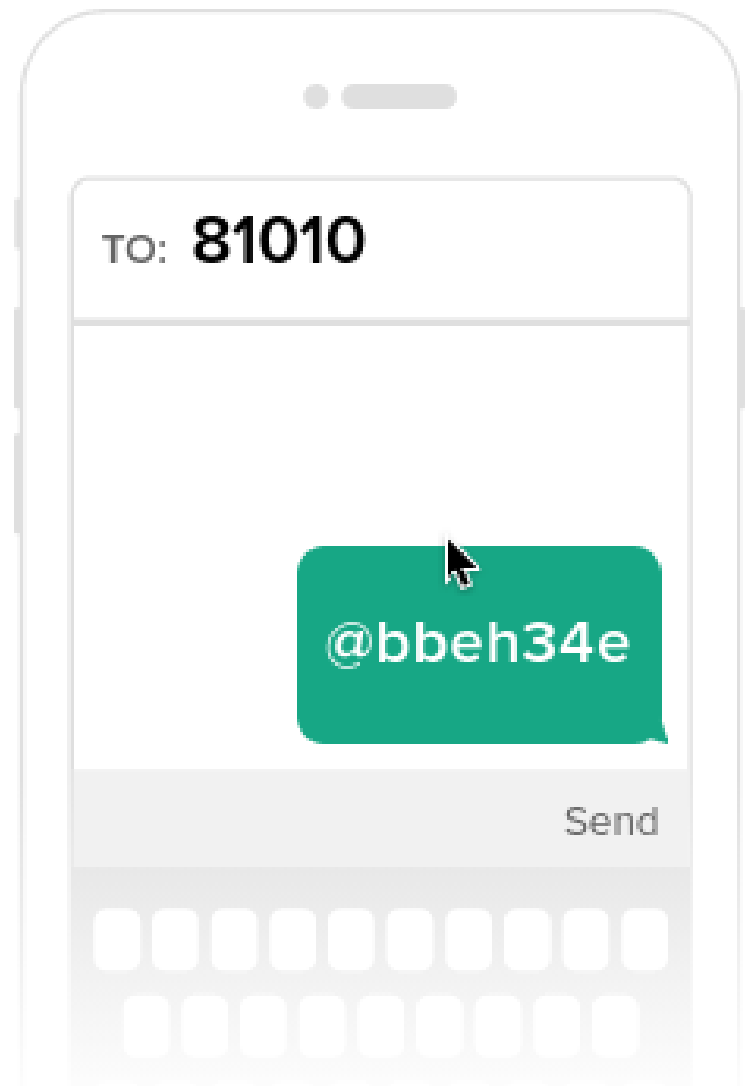
Decorate any area with inspirational messages. Make sure you get permission before starting this service project.
